**(PUBLIC FOOTPATH No. 0.333 BURNTWOOD PARISH)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2022**

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This Order is made by Lichfield District Council ("the Authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Taylor Wimpey West Midlands, Second Floor, Fore 2, Fore Business Park, Huskinson Way, Shirley, Solihull B90 4SS have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

The Staffordshire County Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate off Burntwood Way in the Parish of Burntwood and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up with effect from the date on which Lichfield District Council certify that the works to bring the new site of the footpath, described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order, into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out to their reasonable satisfaction.
2. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
3. There shall upon the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate off Burntwood Way in the Parish of Burntwood described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The full width of that part of Public Footpath, Burntwood No 0.333 commencing off Burntwood Way at Grid Reference 403825 308690 (Point A on the Plan) and proceeding in a generally south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 461 metres to Grid Reference 404220 308458 (Point B on the Plan).

PART 2

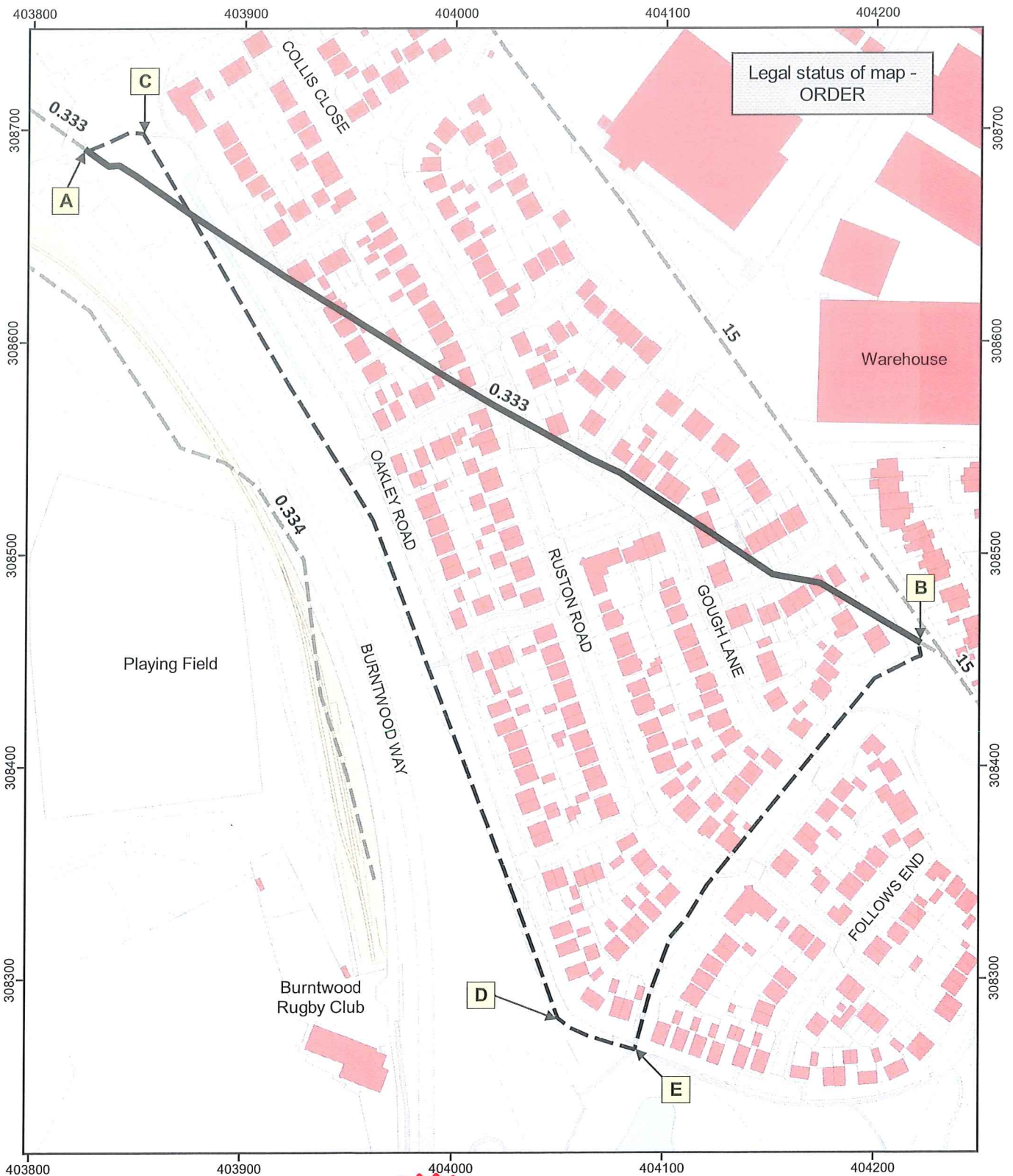
DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

Public Footpath commencing off Burntwood Way at Grid Reference 403825 308690 (Point A on the Plan) and running in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 28 metres to Grid Reference 403851 308698 (Point C on the Plan) then turning and running in a generally south south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 464 metres to Grid Reference 404050 308281 (Point D on the Plan), then in a south easterly direction for approximately 40 metres to Grid Reference 404087 308266 (Point E on the Plan) before turning in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 242 metres to Grid Reference 404220 308458 (Point B on the Plan).

The new footpath shall have a width of 2 metres within which there shall be a:

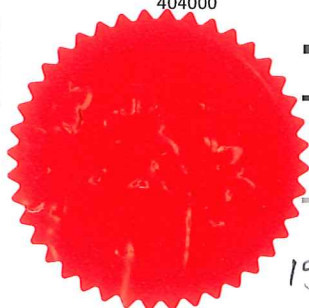
- a) 1 metre surface where amenity grass ride reinforced with gravel is to be used
- b) 1.5 metre surface where self-binding gravel is to be used
- c) 2 metre bitmac surface with tar and chipping dressing where is to be used.


